We, the staff of Lakeshore Marina, would like to say thank you. We have had quite a ride with a lot of interesting challenges of which were overcome. This facility was brought back to life from years of neglect, mismanagement, and poor maintenance. This facility has brought some joys of fishing, a good view of the sunset, good conversations with friends and family, a casual ride with the wind in your hair and the sun on your face, and some fun times at The Blind Tiger. Various possibilities laid in the future with short-term goals and long-term goals. Community gatherings with the view of summer crawfish boils or bar-b-ques, and fall get-togethers. The community of St. Tammany Parish was presented with an opportunity and the right to vote on that opportunity. The community has spoken on their choice in the outcome of the vote.

The e-mail that was mailed out to our clients from the Slidell Ventures II, LLC attorney is true. We will be closing the doors until further notice. You all have until the end of February of 2022 to relocate your boats. The month of February, 2022, you will not be charged a monthly fee. The month of February, we will be moving the boat only once; to a trailer or into the water. Special circumstances will be addressed on an individual basis.

I would like to emphasize the importance of moving your boats. March 1st of 2022, Lakeshore Marina will be discontinuing electricity and water to the wet slips. The electrical towers will be removed as well as the gangways. Access to the dock will no longer exist. The perimeter of the Marina, (that includes the dry stack, the boardwalk, the trailer yard, the wet slips, the parking lot) will be closed off to public access with a chain-link fence. The dry stack will be closed down and locked up with no access to clients or the public.

It has been an interesting ride and I do appreciate you all being patient with us throughout the changes. Clients will be moving their boats and retrieving their trailers throughout this process. Continue to be patient with us as we transition through this process. It would behoove you to aggressively search out other means of storage.
