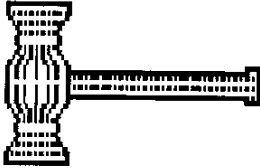

A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

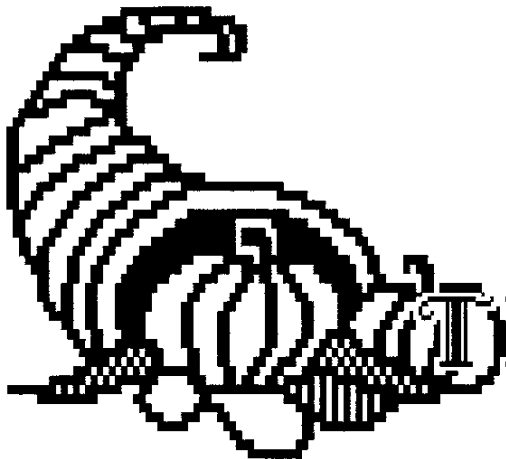

FISHING RODEO REPORT

The first Eden Isles Fishing Rodeo has concluded. And, what a success it was; socially and financially!

The Rodeo, held at the Oak Harbor Boaters' Service Center on October 5 and 6, was not blessed with the most favorable weather conditions. At times, the high winds made events uncomfortable. Regardless, Rodeo attendants had a good time, enjoyed the music provided by two of the area's top bands, as well as delicious food and drink.

Frankie and the Cruisers performed an outstanding Las Vegas style show. The big tent was filled and the dance floor jammed on Saturday night.

The Poker Run was, once again, a success. With 101 entries, a good time was reported by all. We hope to have another Poker Run in the spring - we'll keep you posted.

Financially, preliminary figures indicate an income of approximately \$25,000 to \$26,000. Costs and expenses totaled approximately \$16,000, leaving a net income in excess of \$9,000.

The Rodeo Committee will meet to decide what physical improvements will be made in the Eden Isles/Moonraker area with a portion of the profits. Recommendations will be made to the Association's Board of Directors and brought before the general membership for approval.

The Rodeo's success is undoubtedly attributed to the volunteers that dedicated their time, hard work, ideas and determination to proudly move Eden Isles forward. The Rodeo brought together a large number of Eden Isles residents, all working to benefit the community and its homeowners.

Hopefully, in the next issue of the

Eden Islander, we will be able to publish the names of all of the volunteers that helped to make the Fishing Rodeo and Poker Run such a wonderful success.
