

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Louis Pendarvis

At the last September general membership meeting there was a consensus that Greenforce information regarding collection and disbursement of funds should be addressed in this news letter.

For the record, please be advised:

There are 1,079 homeowners in Eden Isles. Of these, 347 have donated \$35 each to the Greenforce fund totaling, \$12,145. The Greenforce budget for 1998 is \$18,000. With \$12,145 in contributions, this leaves a short fall of \$5,855.

The fund balance as of November 2, 1998 was \$12,989 and expenses paid to date of \$12,260.66 leaving a balance of \$648.34. This is not enough for one cutting.

Our current fund balance bolstered by additional contributions is now \$1,585.22. There is presently enough funds to provide one cut of Eden Isles Blvd. and all common grounds. This will be done before Christmas to ensure our neighborhood will look manicured for the holiday season.

Please be informed:

All Greenforce donations are dedicated to maintenance of Eden Isles Blvd. and all common areas. Greenforce donations are set aside for the express purpose of grass cutting. When these funds are depleted, there will be no grass cutting until adequate funds are received.

Covenant Highlights

Sight Distance at Intersections

No fence, wall, hedge or shrub planting that obstructs sight lines at elevations between 2 and 6 feet above roadways shall be placed or permitted to remain on any corner lot within the triangular area formed by the street property lines and a line connecting them at points 25 feet from the intersection of the street line, or in the case of a rounded property corner, from the intersection of the street property lines extended. The same sight line limitations shall apply on any lot within 10 feet from the intersection of a street property line with the edge of a driveway or alley pavement. No tree shall be permitted to remain within such distances of such intersections unless the foliage line is maintained at sufficient height to prevent obstruction at such sight lines.



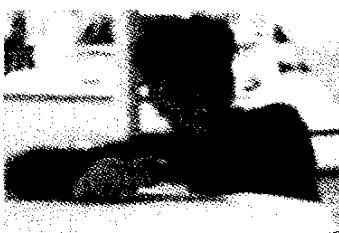

The EIHOA meeting on 10/5/98 (postponed from 9/29/98 due to Georges) proved to be another one of those filled with information that could be used by all residents. We still need one more director to serve on the board next year. Please consider it.

We were fortunate enough to have Sgt. Joe Bernard as our guest speaker, and if you didn't make the meeting, you really missed out. Did you know that areas that implement Neighborhood Watch have in general reduced crime substantially? As much as 85% in the Caliope Projects in New Orleans, and in varying degrees throughout St. Tammany. Different types of locks were passed around, and a video was shown to the attendees giving information and tips. We know law enforcement officers can't be everywhere all the time, so we need to get involved. **We are our best resources.**

Keeping the foliage at a low profile around your house is a good tip, as burglars can't hide there, and identifying your valuables with an engraver with the license number is another one. Many times items are recovered, and never identified by the owners. It is more difficult for burglars to sell marked items, too. Good deadbolt locks on all exterior doors are essential. Also locks on your patio doors, and french doors will tell that burglar to move on down the road to someone else. We love our views of the water, but without the proper locks, when we are not home, those views can come at a high price.

We are looking for that special person to be our Neighborhood Watch Coordinator. This person will act as a liaison with Eden Isles, and Sgt. Bernard. Each area will then be split into blocks, with a block captain who is in charge of setting up Neighborhood Watch meetings, and getting the word out. I have had a very positive response to the mail in forms, but in order for this to work for us, we need a higher participation level.

Please take the time to fill out these forms I have printed again. Our target date to start would be early 1999. With a community this size it will take some time. With our guard service thwarted, maybe we can still progress forward in a positive way; I hope to see ya'll at the next block party on Moonraker, and also at the general Meeting. Give up that one night of watching the boob tube; you will be glad you did. **Get out! Get involved! We can be Bigger, Stronger, Better!!**

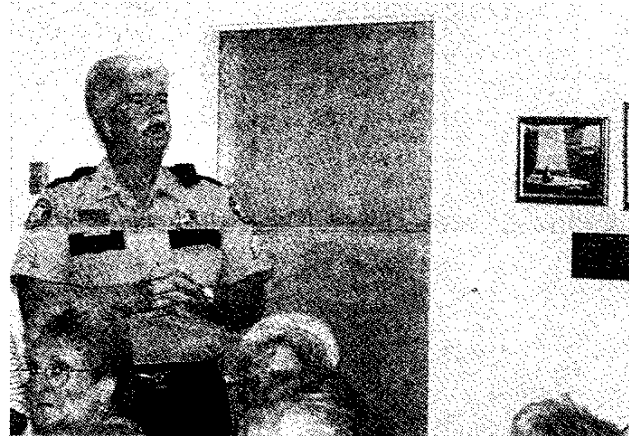

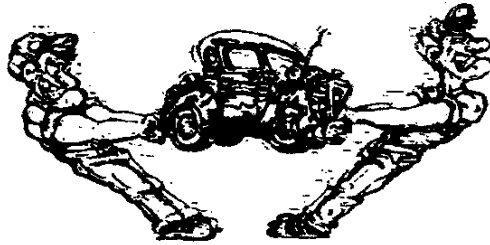

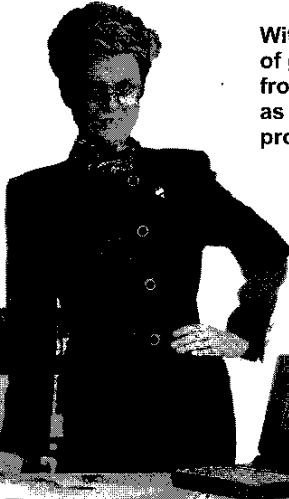
