On November 10th the Security Committee mailed 265 letters to residents who do not participate in paying for the guard service. A total of 24 negative responses was received. As a result of this, 241 additional statements will be mailed January 1st.

The Committee has worked diligently toward being able to maintain this service and to be prepared to fund the second gate after the completion of the interchange. We hope the majority of those receiving statements for the first time on the first of January will join the 360 residents who now pay.

The Security Committee is looking for two volunteers to handle decals and license plates. Your names and telephone numbers would be printed on cards and left at the guard shack for distribution to residents needing these items. Residents would come by your home to pick them up after calling. Decals are \$1.00 and license plates are \$5.00. Monies would be turned into the Chairman for deposit on a monthly basis.




