ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL COMMITTEE REPORT

by Bill Northup -- Unit Four

The Architectural Control Committees exist in order to maintain our property standards consistent with the covenants. The covenants are different from the zoning laws which the parish enforces. The zoning laws are

uniform for the entire parish depending on what the particular zoning classification for a property is. Our covenants are of a considerably higher standard. It is up to us

to enforce our own covenants which we agreed to when we purchased our lots. Any construction of any kind requires OTH a permit from the parish and from the respective Eden Isles Architectural Control Committee. This includes decks and docks and other additions. To get a permit you must submit a detailed plan and drawing of the proposed

construction to the secretary of the ACC of that unit. In unit four this would be Pam White, 111 Gretel Cove; 649-7214.

It is possible that if there are no volunteers to have a functioning

ACC in one of the 5 different Eden Isles units, and someone wants to build something in that unit, then there just IS no one to submit plans to. In this case the covenants are still in effect but it is up to individual property owners to approach offenders

about possible violations. When this occurs AFTER the home is built and moved into, it becomes rather difficult. However, you can bring a lawsuit against the NEW property owner to recover damages for degrading the neighborhood. The builder is out of the picture at that point. If you know someone buying a home in Eden Isles, I would suggest that they make

SURE that plans are on file with the respective ACC. This is especially important if there is an active ACC in your unit and possibly the builder thought it was unnecessary to go through the bother of submitting the plans and paying the fees.

The way I understand it, right now, only Unit Three and Unit Four have active ACCs. The ACC's composition can only be changed by an alteration of the covenants since each ACC was by created the respective covenants. If a majority of the property owners in any unit would like to sign a petition to have a unified Eden Isles ACC, then possibly we could make up for the lack of volunteers in the other units. This is better than trying to sue everybody who is in violation or, the alternative, which is just to let things slide.

The first three months of my new job as head of the Security Committee hasn't been uneventful. subscribers at the present level of \$15 per month.



Ten years ago, a friend of mine bought a condominium in a newly developed area of New Orleans East. The complex had a swimming pool and was nicely landscaped. He paid \$75,000 for it, and after moving in, he installed the most sophisticated burglar alarm system available on the market.

pretty safe place, there were some incidents on our streets lately (among them car theft, theft of electronic equipment, attempt of vehicle burning, break-in and theft of equipment from a guardhouse, and gangtype graffiti) that might indicate future problems. We need to wake up and smell the trouble before it's too late. In large areas of New Orleans, property values plummeted due to the



spread of crime. We don't want the same thing happening here.

For most of us, a home is a lifetime investment which we expect to appreciate with the years. We have to act now to keep Eden Isles safe, so that we can still enjoy walking, jogging, or biking on our streets without having to carry a gun for personal security. Those sophisticated alarm systems might protect your belongings, but they won't protect you from serious losses when crime causes your property's value to dwindle.

If everyone would contribute to Security, we would benefit from 24 hour a day guard service at a smaller cost per resident. Think about it. Is \$180 a year too high a price to protect your investment worth well over a hundred thousand dollars? We have too much to lose to keep going like we have been. Let's all pitch together - there's safety in numbers.
