## REPORT LOW FLYING AIRCRAFT

Unfortunately Eden Isles is subject to an unusually large amount of air traffic because of its location with respect to the Slidell Airport runway. Frequently irresponsible pilots feel the need to endanger our lives by making low passes over our homes.

The FAA recognizes the extreme danger low flying aircraft represent and they have established a minimum altitude of 1,000 feet that aircraft must maintain above Eden Isles. The FAA relies on the citizens of Eden Isles to report all sightings in which aircraft violate this minimum altitude.

If you witness any aircraft (fixed wing or helicopter) flying below 1,000 feet over your home please call the FAA at 1-800-821-1960 or 1-800-992-7433 and give them the aircraft's number along with the time and date of the violation.

Please write these phone numbers in your phone book and help make Eden Isles a safe place to live.

## NEW SECURITY SERVICE

We are most pleased to inform you that as of June 1st, security in Eden Isles is being provided by the Vinson Guard Service. Vinson has been in business since 1963 and we feel that they will provide us with effective and professional security service. If you have any questions or complaints regarding the service being furnished by Vinson, call them at 882-3083. They will be happy to furnish further information and to answer your inquiries.

You may have noted that we were forced to cut back on the guard service a couple of weeks ago. With the Landmark subsidy, and with only 67% participation of residents, we can no longer afford 24-hour security.

At this point Vinson is working with us to supply high visibility coverage at the gate during periods of high vulnerability. Hours at the gate and the hours of patrols may be revised at a later date.

Letters detailing this service - along with the emergency telephone number (monitored 24 hours a day - 7 days a week) have been mailed by your Eden Isles Security Committee.

The I-10 interchange is scheduled to open very shortly. It will require an additional 75 residents to subscribe to this service in order to increase our security service by four hours a day.

This is an excellent opportunity for those of you who have not previously participated in supporting the guard service to do so!

## HURRICANE BOAT SLIPS

All residents of Eden Isles who wish to either renew or to initiate Hurricane Slip Registration for the 1989 season at Marina Eden Isles should do so before June 1, 1989.

Those registered for last year will need to come by the Harbor Master's Office any day except Tuesday from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM and verify their records for any changes and to bring a current Certificate of Insurance for inclusion. Those not previously registered need to pick up an application for completion and filing for future years along with current Certificate of Insurance.

The minimum rental will be a special rate Eden Isles of \$25.00 for 3 nights, \$50.00 for 1 week or \$100.00 for 1 month (monthly also requires a \$50.00 refundable deposit).

## BOATING TIPS

A few checkpoints before getting your boat ready for the season can avoid problems once out in water -

1. Check your battery level, clean terminations and all corrosion, make sure it is secured in the boat.  
  
A battery charge may be required if your boat has been laid up more than 3 months.
2. Check your bilge pump for operation and also the automatic float switch if you have one installed. Clean-up area around pump, clean out strainer on pump and any residue on switch as to avoid sticking. Make sure wire terminations are as high as possible secured by clamps or black ty-wraps so not to drop in bilge or floor area. Check clamps and hoses.
3. Change your lower gear case oil, if it appears white or milky then you probably have a leak in your seals. Get this repaired prior to operation of your boat as not to damage your gears.
4. Change all oil filters, gas (water separator filters) and check all hose and fuel connections for tightness.
5. Change your motor oil in your I/O or inboard. Use OMC, Mercruiser or some other motor manufacturers oil. These oils cost a little more but they are marine type oils, designed for marine application and contain more additives than just regular car motor oils such as rust inhibitors, contain no viscosity improvers as automotive oils do and are designed to operate at a higher temperature and cool your engine at a heavier load or higher RPM.

As you drain your oil it should not be white or milky, if so, you may have blown gaskets from your manifold or head gasket problems. At any rate it should be determined what the problem is and corrected prior to re-filling engine with oil.

## LAWN AND GARDEN TIPS

There has been recent studies that show that trees that are mulched around the base of the trunk out to the drip line form a much denser root system than trees that have to compete with a vigorous turf. Soil moisture was found to be biggest in mulch treatments and lowest in grassed areas. In order for trees to grow vigorously and live long the rooting environment must be good.

Using organic mulch is an excellent way of accomplishing this. Mulch improves the soil, reduces competition, recycles organic material and enhances root development.

Summer Watering is important - The most crucial time for newly planted shrubs and trees is during the first summer. Water thoroughly the upper 6-8" of soil, providing about three soakings a week rather than light sprinklings every day. A mulch of cypress or pine bark will help keep the root zone cool and moist.

Tomatoes. Blossom-end rot of the fruit is very common at this time of year. Symptoms of blossom-end rot appear as a dark brown, leathery scar or rot on the blossom-end (bottom of the fruit). Blossom-end rot is for the most part caused by fluctuation in the water table. Excessive moisture in the soil followed by drought. To help reduce the incidence of this problem irrigate the soil before it gets dry and mulch to help keep the soil evenly moist.

### Summer Pruning of Fruit Trees -

1. Remove unwanted "water sprouts" or shoots on the lower trunk or root stock.
2. Tip-prune rank-growing shoots to encourage lateral branching and better distribution of growth.
3. Eliminate shoots with narrow crotches before they develop.
4. Remove diseased limbs before they spread, such as fireblight on pears.

FIRE INSURANCE RATING SYSTEM

On January 23, 1989, after much effort, Eden Isle's (as well as other sections of St. Tammany Fire District No. 1) rating was dropped from 6 to 4. What this meant to the property owner was that the cost of fire insurance would go down on the average of 39%.

If as the typical homeowner you carry a homeowner's policy covering multi-peril, including fire, only the fire insurance component could be lowered.

However, although the rating revision applies to all insurance companies - and all of them must implement the change - every insurance company, it seems is handling the matter in a different way. Let me explain several of those ways brought to my attention.

Some companies were rating Eden Isles as a 4 already because of the city of Slidell being a 4 and Eden Isles being within 5 miles of a fire station and having an adequate water supply and hydrant system. (Incidentally, these are the two most important factors in determining a fire rating.)

With the condition just described, policyholders with such insurance companies would receive no decrease. They have been enjoying it right along.

2. Other insurance companies were giving a discounted rate and so the subsequent decrease would be less than the standard 39%. Remember, the rating system is a guideline and insurance underwriters have flexibility in setting individual policy costs according to their own tables.

3. Some insurance companies, in anticipation of the decrease of the rating from 6 to 4, implemented the reduction early this year on new policies and renewals.

Other companies will reduce the rate at the time of the renewal of your policy. For example, one homeowner has his policy renewed in October of 1989. At that time, the reduction will go into effect for him.

Still other insurance companies will promptly or very slowly remit a rebate check.

Please note that the wise homeowner will check with his or her insurance company and decide accordingly. Review the factors and comparison shop. Those who worked to lower the rate have done the work, the rest is up to each homeowner.

FIRE PROTECTION

Eden Isles fire protection is provided by St. Tammany Fire District No. 1, which is supported by Parish taxation. The district includes the city of Slidell and unincorporated areas from the lake to the Miss. border to halfway to Lacombe to halfway to Pearl River.

This is the largest fire district in the Parish and consists of the following:

- 1. Approximately 60 career (paid) fire-fighters.
2. Five full-time fire stations.
3. Three volunteer fire organizations.

At Eden Isles, initial fire response is from Station One at Third and Bouscaren Streets, and from the North Shore Volunteer Fire Department located on Carr Drive. Individual volunteer members of the N.S.V. F.D. live in Eden Isles, and when home, respond directly to the fire.

Presently, the N.S.V.F.D. is conducting its annual fund drive. Much of the costs incurred by this group is paid, not by tax dollars, but funds of their own. Costs like fuel, repairs, new equipment, and fire apparatus must be addressed.

Recently, a second-hand pumper was bought at auction from the City of New Orleans. The pumper is being renovated at great effort by the membership, especially by two men who have put hundreds of hours of hard work into it. When this new unit goes into service, fire protection in the North Shore - Eden Isles area will improve.

When you receive the letter from N.S.V.F.D., please contribute. An amount of \$20 is sought from each home and business for this vital function. Contributions may be sent to 127 Carina Circle.

Also, those wishing to join the N.S.V.F.D. are welcomed. The company meets usually two Tuesdays a month.

**FINAL APPROVAL FOR I-10 EDEN ISLES INTERCHANGE SIGNS HAS BEEN ACCEPTED**




