## SECURITY INCREASED

As of July 1st, we intend to increase our guard service from 16 hours a day to 19 hours a day.

After Vinson Security started providing service in Eden Isles, we had many calls from residents expressing their concerns regarding the fact that guards were spending too much time making patrols and not enough time at the gate. After discussing the situation with David Wortmann of Vinson Security, it was decided the guards would make one patrol each 8-hour shift. These patrols cover all of Eden Isles and take close to two hours. During the past couple of weeks they have reported five stop signs and five street signs vandalized. This was reported to the Sheriff's Office and they have increased patrols in the subdivision. Guards have also reported an increase in vehicles being driven at excessive speeds. License numbers have been recorded and the Sheriff notified.

These incidents have multiplied since summer vacations started for school age children. If you have teenagers, perhaps you will discuss these problems. All cooperation is appreciated.

We hope the additional guard hours will eliminate some of these incidents. If you have suggestions, your Committee will appreciate receiving them. Send to:

LAWN AND GARDEN TIPS FOR JUNE

Insect and disease problems -

Bark lice cause a web formation all over the trunk and branches of trees. No control is necessary.

Bagworms are caterpillars covered with pieces of leave and other ornamentals. Control them with Diazinon - make applications 10-14 days apart.

Foliage browning on juniper may be due to spider mites. Control with Keltbare.

Oakleaf blister is a light green to yellowish blister on the upper leaf surface of Oak leaves with depressed areas under the leaf. It occurs in the spring as new leaves begin to unfold. It will not kill the tree and no control is necessary now. Next spring as the leaves unfold spray with fixed copper, three times at seven ten day intervals.

Leaf yellowing of azaleas, camellias, gardenias may be due to iron chlorosis. To control, spray with Liquid Iron. Lack of water or too much water can cause this problem.

Foliage browning of junipers may be due to a canker disease or blight. Prune out affected areas and spray with Bordeaux, fixed copper, or Broad Spectrum fungicide by Fertiloom.

Buckeye rot disease on tomatoes, be sure to use a mulch. It is spread by soil splashing up on fruit either by watering or rain.

Blossom end rot A dark brown or black spot appears on the bottom of the fruit or the blossom end. It's cause by fluctuations in water and calcium deficiency in the fruit. Water the ground to a depth of 6-8". As the tomato begins to develop spray with Stop rot.

LAWN AND GARDEN TIPS (continued)

Yellowing of lower leaves of vegetables especially tomatoes may be due to a lack of nitrogen fertilizer, lack of water, leaf miners or disease.

Leaf miners are caused by a fly that lays its eggs in a leaf. When the larva hatch out they eat tunnels which appear as tracks in the leaves. Control with Diazinon.

This is the best time of the year to plant palms. The soil is warm and this allows the plant time to make vigorous root growth.

BOATING SAFETY - (BOATOWNER'S RESPONSIBILITY)

Now is the time to review your safety equipment aboard and ensure your safety as well as others you may bring along for the trip. Everyone assumes that nothing will happen while out boating, but many hazards unseen and problems occur while out for a trip. If your boat stops while out what do you do? A VHF (ship to ship/ ship to shore) can help resolve the communications. A call to the Marine Operator (via a charge to your home telephone) can get you in touch with someone to help or relay a message.

Do you have enough life preservers aboard? 16' or above must have one Type I, II, or III, IV for each person aboard plus a throw ring or square cushion preferably with rope tied to the throw, a horn or signaling device, a paddle, a small bucket and water bailer, a fire extinguisher and first aid kit.

If you need one of the above and didn't have it, could you suffer the consequences?

Several street lights have been reported out and CLECO has been notified. If you notice that a street light is out, notify Safety or call CLECO directly.

### SOME THOUGHTS ON SECURITY

Security is always a major concern at Eden Isles. With the opening soon of the I-10 Exit -- and even now, for those who use the new roadways illegally - Eden Isles will experience some unwelcome visitors.

Unfortunately, with the withdrawal of Landmark's financial support and the less than 100% participation in security, we just cannot afford 24-hour security. That 24, or nearly 24-hour security was a practical deterrent to crime has become obvious in recent days.

There are a number of reasons for the increase in burglaries and vandalism. For example, this is the season for such crimes to increase, schools are out, and there are 24-hour bars in the immediate area. However, the decrease in guard service seems to be one of the major reasons.

The Sheriff's Department has increased patrols and road stake-outs, but they cannot be there all day. Those who advocate police patrols without 24-hour guard service should well note the current situation. We had it good before!

What can we do? Plenty!

1. Join Security so membership will be as close to 100% as possible.
2. Lock your doors and cars.
3. Get a security/alarm system for your house and car.
4. Let's start a Neighborhood Crime Watch.
5. Report any suspicious activity to the Sheriff promptly.
6. Sign the Security Petition if you have not so far.
7. The District Commission has been meeting for at least a year. Attend their Monday meetings and tell them you want 24-hour security.

### THE SECURITY PETITION

As announced at the May Homeowner's Meeting, 299 residents had signed the petition. To date, 33 more have signed.

It is obvious that the majority of people want gate guard service. There is no question about it.






