

# 4 LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT



Once again, we have been able to add hours to our weekly schedule for the summer, and now enjoy the most coverage in recent history. Thanks to all of the good citizens for your loyal support and commitment to the Eden Isles Guard Service.

However, we will still have to suffer the indifference of some parents to their where-abouts and anti-social Most of our "crime" in Eden Isles activities. is of the petty variety, committed Most recently, on three different iuveniles. occasions after 3:00 am, the guard houses were vandalized. It was reported that on one occasion, three juveniles on bicycles were observed in the area at that hour. Now in some eyes, the destruction of and trespass on private property, harassment guards, violations of the law, etc. may be considered "pranks" but in the eyes of the victims and law enforcement officials, this directly is attributable irresponsible parenting and is but a portent of things to come.

Back in the time of old English common law, if someone was bent on criminal behavior and if another member of the community knew or saw it and did nothing to stop or apprehend him, that person who stood by and allowed the criminal to wreak his havoc was punished. Perhaps we need a dose of this kind of thought and law applied to the parents of errant juveniles.






