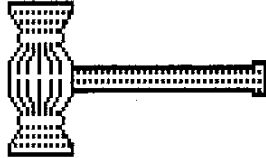

SECURITY REPORT

Once again, we have been able to add hours to our weekly schedule for the summer, and now enjoy the most coverage in recent history. Thanks to all of the good citizens for your loyal support and commitment to the Eden Isles Guard Service.

However, we will still have to suffer the indifference of some parents to their childrens' whereabouts and anti-social activities. Most of our "crime" in Eden Isles is of the petty variety, committed by juveniles. Most recently, on three different occasions after 3:00 am, the guard houses were vandalized. It was reported that on one occasion, three juveniles on bicycles were observed in the area at that hour. Now in some eyes, the destruction of and trespass on private property, harassment of the guards, violations of the law, etc. may be considered "pranks" but in the eyes of the victims and law enforcement officials, this behavior is directly attributable to irresponsible parenting and is but a portent of things to come.

Back in the time of old English common law, if someone was bent on criminal behavior and if another member of the community knew or saw it and did nothing to stop or apprehend him, that person who stood by and allowed the criminal to wreak his havoc was punished. Perhaps we need a dose of this kind of thought and law applied to the parents of errant juveniles.

On another subject -- our American flag was in poor condition at the Highway entrance and will be replaced by one donated by **Bob Hanson** and **Henrick Eike** (who is also attending to the tree that chewed the flag). Thanks to these gentlemen, both of

whom are members of the Homeowners' Association Board of Directors, for their contribution to the community.

Personal thanks, also, to our President, **Sid Menard** for his unflagging efforts to assist anyone, anytime, in any endeavor to improve Eden Isles. The words "cooperation" and "commitment" are woefully inadequate to describe the job he has done and is doing in providing the leadership to build a united and cohesive community through the Homeowners' Association.
