Plans are underway to make the upcoming school year an enjoyable one for both the students and parents at Abney Elementary. Several Eden Isles residents will be serving on the 1988-89 PTA Board. They are: Jill Spizale, President; Dollie Wortmann, Treasurer and Cindy Spilling, Hospitality Chairperson.

At the end of the 1987-88 school year, Abney received the honor of having the school newsletter name "Best School Newsletter at the Elementary Level" in the State of Louisiana.

One very important program we would like to take part in this year is "Partners-in-Education: Adopt-A-School" sponsored by the Chamber of Commerce and the St. Tammany Parish School board. The program offers businesses and organizations the opportunity to assist in the overall effort to give all students the best education possible. No business is too big or too small. As you know, due to budget cuts this year every school in the parish will be affected in one way or another. At Abney, we are facing the loss of our full-time music teacher. Mrs. Dane had to resign at the end of last year to relocate with her family. The School Board took advantage of her resignation to abolish the full-time position. It seems Abney will be given a part-time teacher to share with another school. We have already lost our P.E. teachers - there are no art teachers - and now our music teacher is at risk. Had Mrs. Dane not had to resign, it is doubtful that this position would be abolished. This position is one of

four cuts in the parish. The other three teachers had temporary teaching certificates. This is not the issue in the Abney teacher case. The children should not be penalized because the teacher had to relocate.

Another issue directly affecting Abney will come up at the next School Board meeting. That is the positions of the Resource Helping Teachers and the Curriculum Specialists. These teachers are vitally important to our school system. We all understand budget cuts - but these cuts are not acceptable. Get in touch with your School Board Representative - let him know the Abney parents want our music teacher and our Resource Helping Teacher on a full-time basis. The Abney PTA is monitoring this situation and will be in touch with all parents shortly.
