POLICE JUROR REPORT

Within the next week work should begin on paving of Eden Isles Drive. During this period, driving conditions will be hazardous and at times inconvenient so please drive with caution and patience. Also, those of you who park on Eden Isles Drive, must find alternate parking during construction.

Engineering studies are currently underway on Moonraker Drive, the Moonraker Bridge, Rampage Loop and Windward Passage. As the final reports are made available to me, I will let you know at a later date when these projects are to begin.

As for Parish law on boat docks. The law has been changed to comply with the Restrictive Covenants. It is permissible to construct a boat dock from property line to property line, however, any structure (i.e. - boat house, boat shed, gazebo, etc.) must be set back five feet from the property line. In the future, should someone violate this law, you not only can be taken to court by your neighbor, but you will be fined by the Parish and be forced to remove the structure.

Speaking of building docks and doing additions to your house, etc. Most of this type requires a Parish permit - this includes swimming pools. To find out if the work you are contemplating does require a permit, call the Permits & Violations Office at 646-4176 and inquire. Should you be caught doing any of this type work without a permit, the fines, plus the permit costs would be substantial.

My thanks to Ann Gremmillion and her hard of volunteers for the clean up efforts in the canals and on U.S. 11. It seems that it is a losing battle, but with the efforts of all these fine people, the difference will be made and we will have a much nicer place to live.

Originally, I had intended to devote the bulk of this column to safety and the babysitter, a topic that will be covered in a later column. The pressing topic at hand -- exacerbated by recent events -- is lightning.

Lightning damages property, sets fires, and hurts and kills people. According to statistics, a person is more likely to die of lightning than snake bite. Living on the edge of the Lake, we experience a lot of this dangerous spectacle of nature.

So far this year, this writer knows of four residents and one boat hit by lightning in Eden Isles; two persons have been injured. Take the reasonable precautions to safeguard yourself and yours. Properly installed lightning rods do protect buildings. Unplugging the sensitive appliances, such as computers during a storm is a good idea. No surge arrestor can withstand a strike.

As for protection of persons, the National Fire Protection Association has published some excellent survival tips as included in paper.

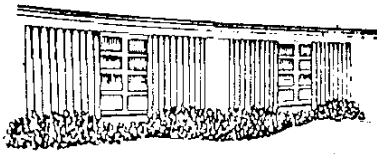
DEFACING PUBLIC PROPERTY

We do not want to have to have you cited, but if this continues, we will see that you are visited by the authorities. These signs are easy to trace to the owner because they usually have your address or phone number on them.

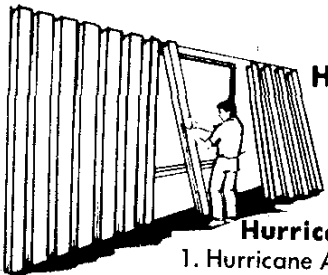

Guide for personal safety during thunderstorms

National Fire Protection Association
Lightning Protection Code

Unless you have been burrowed inside a building or living underground the past few weeks, you will have noticed an incredible amount of thunderstorms in the area. The purpose of this article is to furnish a guide for personal safety during thunderstorms.

Do not go outside or remain out during thunderstorms unless it is necessary. Seek shelter as follows:

- a. dwellings or other buildings that are protected against lightning.
- b. underground shelters such as subways, tunnels and caves.
- c. large metal-frame buildings.
- d. large unprotected buildings.
- e. enclosed automobiles, buses and other vehicles with metal tops and bodies.
- f. enclosed metal trains and street cars.
- g. enclosed metal boats or ships.
- h. boats that are protected against lightning.
- i. city streets that may be shielded by nearby buildings.

If possible, avoid the following places that offer little or no protection from lightning:

- a. small unprotected buildings, barns, sheds, etc.
- b. tents and temporary shelters.
- c. automobiles with non-metallic or open tops.
- d. non-metal or open trailers.

Certain locations are extremely hazardous during thunderstorms and should be avoided if at all possible.

Approaching thunderstorms should be anticipated and the following locations avoided



- d. automobiles with non-metallic or open tops.

It may not always be possible to choose a location that offers good protection from lightning. Follow these rules when there is a choice in selecting locations:

- a. seek depressed areas — avoid hilltops and high places.
- b. seek dense woods — avoid isolated trees.
- c. seek buildings, tents and shelters in low areas — avoid unprotected buildings and shelters in high areas.
- d. If you are hopelessly isolated in an exposed area and you feel your hair stand on end, indicating that lightning is about to strike, drop to your knees and bend forward, putting your hands on your knees. Do not lie flat on the ground or place your hands on the ground. □

when storms are in the immediate vicinity:

- a. hilltops and ridges.
- b. areas on top of buildings.
- c. open fields and golf courses.
- d. parking lots and tennis courts.
- e. swimming pools, lakes and seashores.
- f. near wire fences, clotheslines, overhead wires and railroad tracks.
- g. under isolated trees.

In addition, you should avoid use of or contact with electrical appliances, telephones and plumbing fixtures during a storm.

It is especially hazardous to be riding in or on any of the following during lightning storms:

- a. open tractors or other farm machinery operated in open fields.
- b. golf carts, scooters, bicycles or motorcycles.
- c. open boats without masts and Hovercraft.

THE EDEN ISLES COMMUNITY SERVICES
DISTRICT PLAN

The District Commissioners have agreed on a plan for both Security and Ground Maintenance of Eden Isles. The plan also calls for funds to allow the District to enact ordinances and assist in covenant enforcement.

The cost of this plan will be \$29.16 per month for single family residents within Eden Isles and vacant lot owners will be paying \$14.58 per month. The property owners within the gates will pay the lion's share of this plan because all other properties outside the gates will not benefit from security or ground maintenance. For the 67% of the residents who now voluntarily contribute \$10.00 per month for security, the plan will be an increase of \$19.16 per month to fund 24 hour gate guards at both the Highway 11 gate and the new guard gate to be built at Eden Isles Drive and Marina Drives. The plan does not actually specify in detail the type security because some Commissioners want to provide for flexibility in the event some ruling may not permit private security guards. The budget also allows for additional monies to be spent on a roving patrol and possibly a water patrol.

This plan will be on the November ballot and all "registered" voters will vote to decide if the plan can be enacted and money collected as the plan outlines. If the plan is defeated at the ballot box, there will of course not be any funds for additional security guards on the new gate unless those people who voluntarily contribute are willing to at least triple their contribution. We now provide only 19 hours of private security per day at the present levels of voluntary contribution. In order to fund 24 hour gate guards, those residents who now voluntarily contribute will have to almost triple their monthly contribution and will not get the common grounds maintained as they will in the District's plan.

DISTRICT PLAN (continued)

The opposition to this or any plan has already surfaced and begun organizing to defeat it at the ballot box. Those opponents will be making a door to door effort to convince residents that this plan should be defeated because Eden Isles does not need a plan to deal with the expected influx of outside traffic that will occur when the I-10 interchange is opened or have our common grounds maintained because everything is fine the way it is.

The Eden Isles Homeowners' Association Board of Directors is now in favor of this plan because the Board knows how things are right now. The Board is currently able to provide funds to have a tractor cut the common grounds four times per year because there is a temporary profit from private lot cuttings. As the private lots are developed there will be no money to cut the common grounds. Our security service will lose participants when they see the lack of security at both gates if present funding levels are continued. The volunteer system of paying for services actually has our guard service running between 14 and 19 hours per day depending upon when people send in their money for security.

If you favor private security guards at the entrances to Eden Isles and bimonthly mowings, edging and weeding of Eden Isles Drive and all other common grounds within our community then we urge you to register to vote and make a point to go vote for this plan because there will not be another opportunity to provide these services until 1992 when a new board is elected. The current Commissioners have expressed a lack of interest in pursuing a subsequent plan if this plan is defeated in November. If the 67% of our community who pay for security unite to approve this plan then the soon to be vocal opponents among the other 33% will not be able to defeat it as they intend.

INSECTS

GARDEN TIPS FOR AUGUST

CAUTION! - Garden edgers or trimmers can be dangerous! Garden edgers or trimmers which use a monofilament line for cutting down weeds and grasses can be very damaging to shrubs, vines and young trees. If the monofilament line is allowed to wrap around the stem or trunk of these plants, part of the bark will be removed with each contact of the line. If this is done completely around the plant, the circle of bark may be removed from the stem resulting in a girdling. When the ringing of bark or girdling occurs, no food can be translocated to the root system. In a period of several months the root system starves and dies. Of course, when this happens the top of the plant does not get water or nutrients that it needs for growth, and then it dies.

While garden trimmers that employ a monofilament line such as weed-eater or weed-wacker are very useful for controlling undesirable vegetation in our gardens, use them with care and keep the monofilament lines from coming in contact with the stems of your shrubs, vines and trees.

White fly - on tomatoes, cucumbers, and other vegetables. Control with Thiodan or Dimethoate.

Stinkbug damage - cause yellow spots on tomatoes. Spray with 50% Sevin or Thiodan.

Leaf minus - on tomatoes and other vegetables, use Diazinon or Dimethoate.

Sad webworm in the lawn - White moths fly up from the lawn when walked upon. Control with Dursban granules.

Borers - They may be found in various shade trees especially Pine and Willow. To control spray with Lindare.

Aphids - collect on tender shoots. Control with Malathion or Diazinon.

Bagworms - mainly on Junipus. Control with Malathion or Dursban.

Web formation on trees caused by psocids. It is not harmful and no control is necessary. These are small insects that feed on algae present on tree trunks.

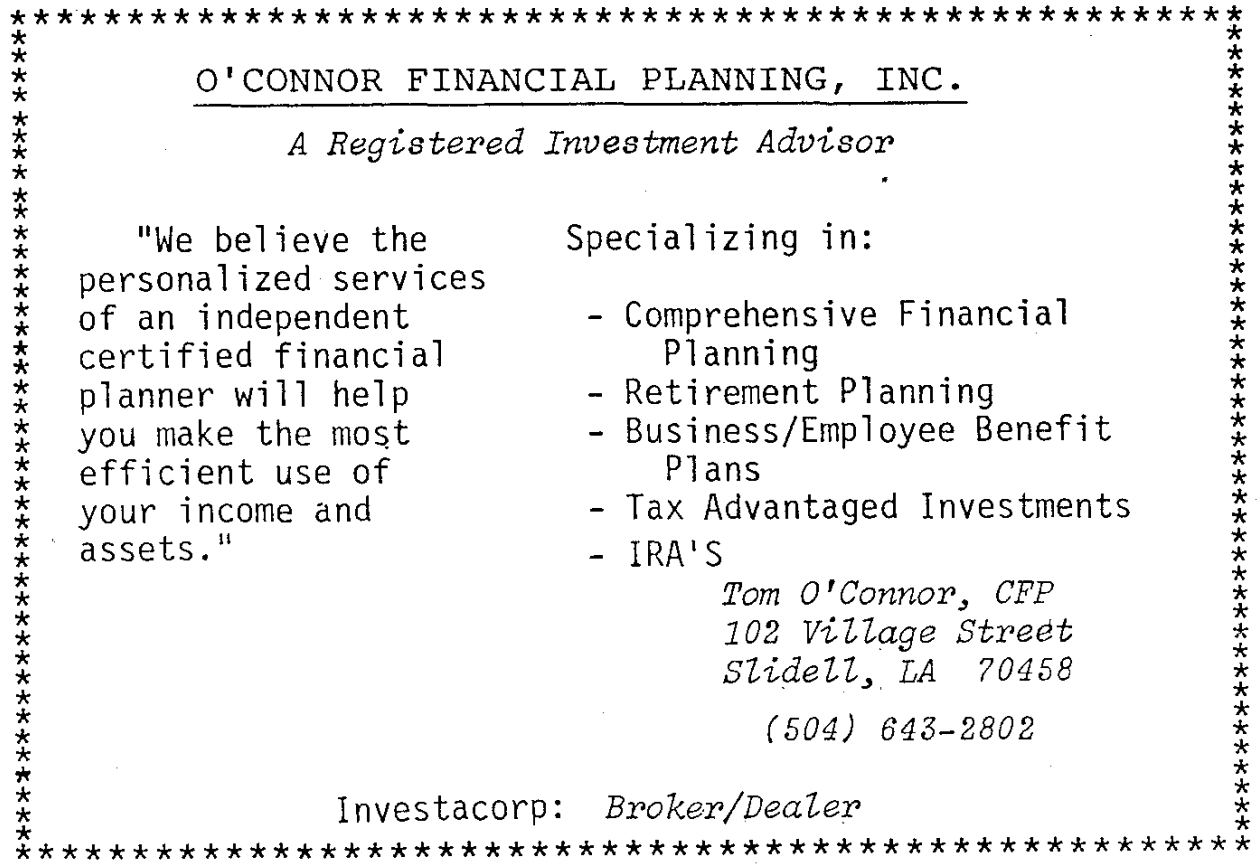

PETA HISTORY

People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals (PETA) is a non-profit charity organization headquartered in Washington, D.C. PETA was incorporated to educate policy-makers and the public to the issues involving the intense, prolonged, and unjustifiable abuse of animals, and to promote an understanding of the inherent rights of animals to be treated with respect and decency.

Founded in 1980, PETA is the fastest growing animal rights organization in the United States. In 1983, readers of Agenda, the animal protection community's national, independent news magazine, voted PETA the No. 1 organization in the country that has done the most to further protection of animals.

Since its inception, PETA has been responsible for such breakthroughs as the closing down of the largest horse slaughter operation in the United States; the first and only arrest and criminal conviction of animal experimenter in the United States on charges of cruelty to animals; the first confiscation of abused laboratory animals under court-ordered search and seizure warrant; and an order by U.S. Secretary of Defense Casper Weinberger that stopped the use of cats and dogs in all military wound laboratories. PETA also publicized 70 hours of graphic videotape documenting the savagely cruel treatment of primates at the University of Pennsylvania Head Injury Clinic; the lab's funding was suspended.

PETA's animal protection casework brings members of the scientific community together with members of the judicial and legislative communities to halt abusive operations and practices. Such cases, aided by thorough investigative work, Congressional involvement, and international media coverage, frequently result in widespread short- and long-term changes that improve the quality of life for thousands of animals.






