If you observe a violation, call the St. Tammany Parish Water Patrol (641-4100) or the HOTLINE at 781-0091.

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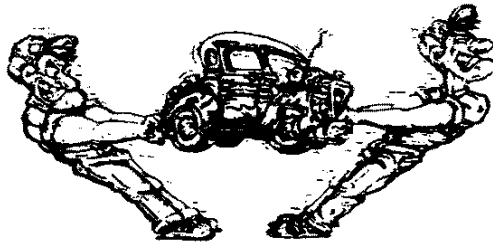
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MEMBERSHIP

TAX TIP by M. Dale Wood, Jr., CPA, MS* (*-in Taxation)

Don't confuse the "child-care" tax credit with the new "child" tax credit. The "child-care" tax credit relates to expenses incurred to care for a qualifying person. The "child" tax credit is NOT dependent upon expenses. Beginning in 2001, each son, daughter, stepchild or eligible foster child that is under the age of 17 may qualify you for a tax credit of up to \$600 per child. Consult your tax advisor for complete details.

AND - the last deadline for filing an individual income tax return is October 15!

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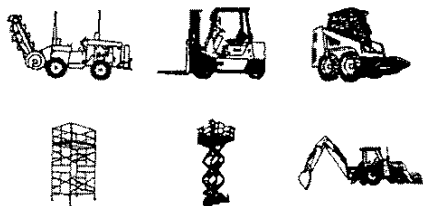
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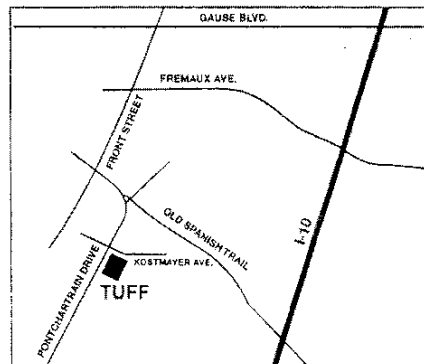
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Garden Club

September brings cooler weather and the urge to get back in the swing after the lazy, hazy days of summer. The members of the Eden Isles Garden Club have really hit the September "road" to the new year at breakneck speed. Under the guidance of President Ann Courrage, the calendar of events, happenings and opportunities was presented at the first meeting of the new club year. Linda Cunningham, ably assisted by Jane Bachemin, Nell Forstall, Gwen Knowles, and Betty Newman, opened her home for the meeting on September 4th. The first program of the year was presented by Yvette Cutrer of Ponchatoula on the making of living wreaths. She used hydrated polymers mixed with the soil before planting the wreath. The polymers absorb many times their weight in water and release it into the soil thereby decreasing the frequency of watering. The polymers can be used in the landscape as well as in potted plantings and wreaths. Who said there is nothing new under the sun?

Later in the month the club will be headed to the Clower-Thornton Nature Preserve in Pass Christian.

You might have seen five members of Wylene Heatherly's Circle committee out early the morning of September 5th weeding and pruning the entrance plantings. They even pruned the holly bushes in front of the fountains. They wanted to thank the anonymous lady who showed up with iced tea, melon, and a "thank you" for the workers. It is nice to know the volunteer work that is done is noticed and appreciated.

Norma Hastings and her committee members have been diligent in their work all summer with the Yard of the Month selection. The August winners were: 1st place - 118 Blackfin Cove, 2nd place - 314 Charles Ct. and 3rd place - 118 Constellation. The September winners are: 1st place - 245 Blackfin Cove, 2nd place - 217 Ranger Place and 3rd place went to 205 Eydie Lane. Please notice that Blackfin Cove has had the top spot for the past two months - I wonder if they are issuing a challenge to the rest of the subdivision.

Not only the members involved with YOM were busy over the summer. Pam White and the Slidell Rehab Garden committee watered, potted, pruned and spruced up the plants for the Rehab's plant sale in late August. The rehab (rehabilitation) garden at SMH was begun in August 1994 by recreation therapist, Kris Schmitz. The garden exists for the purpose of teaching adaptive gardening techniques to patients. Skills learned by patients can then be applied in the home setting. The Eden Isles Garden Club has been involved with this project from almost the beginning.

The club has two field trips for the month of September. The first one was to the home of Yvette Cutrer, this month's speaker. Fourteen of us carpooled to Ponchatoula to learn "onsite" about the large variety of plants that can be used in a living wreath. Having reached lunchtime, we stopped at A Taste of Bavaria to dine. One of the things that was new was a rather large snake in one of the greenhouses (I have NO first-hand knowledge of the critter since, when i heard someone mention the word, i immediately went inside the shop). I'm sure it was NOT the 20 foot Anaconda that I always envision at the utterance of the word but.....you can never be too careful. Everyone survived and continued shopping. When the cars were full, we came home.

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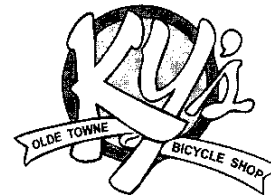
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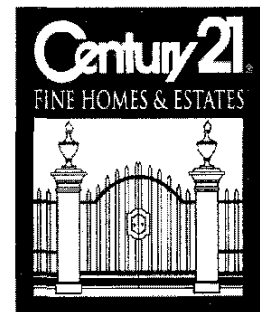


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BIOGRAPHY

KENNETH L. BOURGEOIS, Major USMC (Ret) and OTIS BOURGEOIS, SEAMAN FIRST CLASS, U.S. NAVY. Two of the five brothers who served in the United States Military are residents of Eden Isles. Kenneth lives at 173 Pebble Beach and Otis lives at 111 Lake Lawn. RENE BOURGEOIS, SERGEANT, USMC resides in Diamond Head, MS. The other two brothers now deceased are ROBERT CLARK BOURGEOIS, WARRANT OFFICER, USAF. (Ret) and CLARENCE BOURGEOIS, U.S. COAST GUARD and STAFF SERGEANT, USMC.

Kenneth joined the Marines in 1947, and in 1951 he was engaged in the Korean conflict. He was awarded the Purple Heart for wounds received in action on September 20, 1951. Upon return to the United States he was assigned to the Marine Corps Reserve and Recruitment District. He immediately reenlisted in the regular Marine Corps and was assigned to the Second Marine Aircraft Wing as the Operations Chief. During his entire military career, Kenneth served in many activities including Atomic Exercises in Nevada, with the U.S. Army as a Nuclear, Biological and Motivation at Parris Island. Gunnery Sergeant Kenneth Bourgeois was commissioned Second Lieutenant on August 22, 1962, and First Lieutenant in September 1963. In 1967 Kenneth was promoted to Captain and went to Vietnam to assist in the return of deceased Marines who gave their lives there fighting for freedom. Captain Bourgeois again, served in Vietnam from 1969-1970 and was promoted to Major in August, 1970. Along with the Purple Heart, Kenneth was awarded service medals and commendations from the Navy, Marine Corps, Major Bourgeois retired from the United States Marine Corps in November, 1972.

Otis served in the United States during WWII.

Rene served in the United States Marine Corps during the Korean Conflict.

Clarence served in the United States Coast Guard and later in the Marine Corps.

Robert served in the United States Army Air Corps with General Jimmie Doolittle in the raid on Tokyo, Japan in April 1942. This writer had the honor and privilege to meet Robert weeks before his death. He shared with me his exploit of the bombing raid on Tokyo and later crash landing of his B25 aircraft in a rice paddy in China. There is a section at the D Day Museum dedicated in his honor.
