## Around the first of September we were able to

get a full compliment of guards to fill the schedule that I had requested. This schedule called for two guards all night 7 days a week, one daytime guard during the week, and no daytime guard on weekends. The thinking behind this is that our most vulnerable hours are during the dark hours. The daytime guards help when we are away at work, but are not needed when we are around our homes on the weekends.



We are still lacking in supporters to fund this level of guard service. We need about 500 to 525 families per quarter to pay for this level of service. During the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd quarters we had 319 & 425 families participate. So far this year we have had 466 different families participate in the service at one time or another, but not all at the same time. If you are not currently contributing, please reconsider your position for the fourth quarter coming up next week. With the holidays coming up, we will have to consider adding some off duty deputy patrols, which will cost us extra moneys that we desperately need.

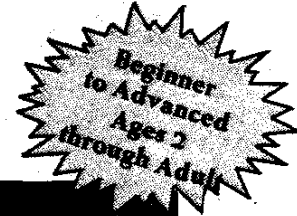
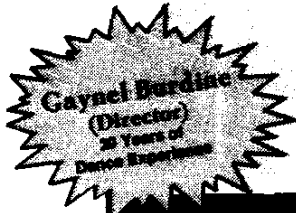

This was the only major problem that we have had this summer, and something that could not have been prevented by the guards. It would be wise to note that you should keep your cars locked at all times when you are not able to watch them, even when in your own driveways.

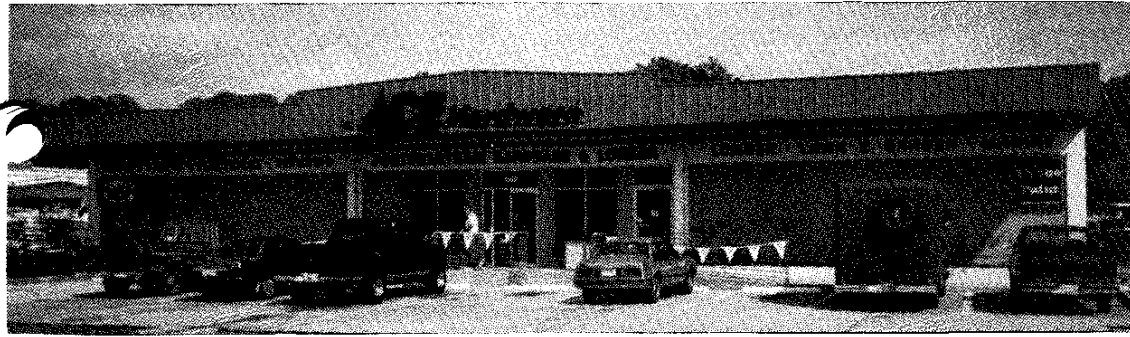

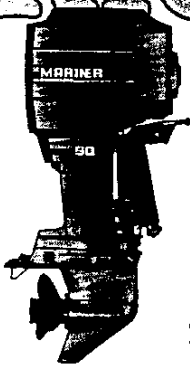

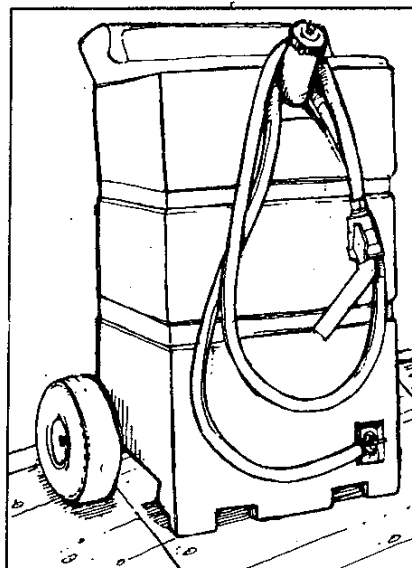

## RESULTS OF MAILOUT SURVEY

In August, a survey was sent to all Moonraker residents (about 200 households) to find their opinion on a proposed bike lane to be included with the resurfacing of the first 4,100 feet of Moonraker. So far we have gotten back 83 surveys, yielding the following results (as of 9-10-94):

**35 voted AGAINST and 48 voted FOR the bike path;**

Of those voting FOR the bike path,	26	wanted it
on the on the LAKE SIDE,	14	wanted it
on the CANAL SIDE, and	8	had NO
PREFERENCE as to which one.		

Another mailout survey was also sent to all residents in Unit 4 except for Rampage Loop and Windward Passage. These streets were omitted because they seem to be in okay shape, but those residents are welcome to help contribute to whatever streets they feel need repair the most (remember that if the street that you contribute to doesn't get overlaid, you are supposed to get your check back from the Block Captain).



The voluntary street assessment surveys were return mailed directly to Gary Rinck, and thus we don't know the numbers associated with that survey. We do have some volunteer "Block Captains" if you should want to put your check in their hands. They are: Mr. Herbert LeBlanc of 111 Lorelei at 649-7920 and Mrs. Diane Romano of 106 Blackfin Cove at 847-1973. These Block Captains should only collect checks from their own blocks. I know everybody is wondering who the block captain for Charles Court is. Well, we don't have one yet.

Personally, I would really like to see our subdivision get some much needed street repairs. \$100 for a fresh paving overlay on some of these streets would surely help the property values in Eden Isles (it might also help keep our car tires in alignment!). In the past, the repairs have only consisted of simple patches that didn't hold up well at all. Now we have a chance to improve the entire surface.

# Creating Eden Isles was just a small part of the story.

Once the streets and canals were built, lots had to be sold and houses constructed. But people had to want to live there in order for that to happen, and as far as most of them were concerned, the area was just unpleasant and swampy. All the massive construction equipment didn't help its image, either, and those in charge of advertising Eden Isles had a formidable task on their hands. They had to replace these views with more cheerful ones of how it would look in a few years, and they had to do it without help or cooperation from Slidell's real estate agents.

Part of their technique was simple. They published brochures showing the brighter side of Eden Isles, with special emphasis on the waterfront. The ads told about fishing and boating; the developing golf course, marina, and clubhouse; and the seclusion despite accessibility and closeness to New Orleans. They showed

gatherings and sometimes printed photographs and short descriptions of some of the houses in Eden Isles. This probably served to let people see what the land could be instead of it was like at the time.

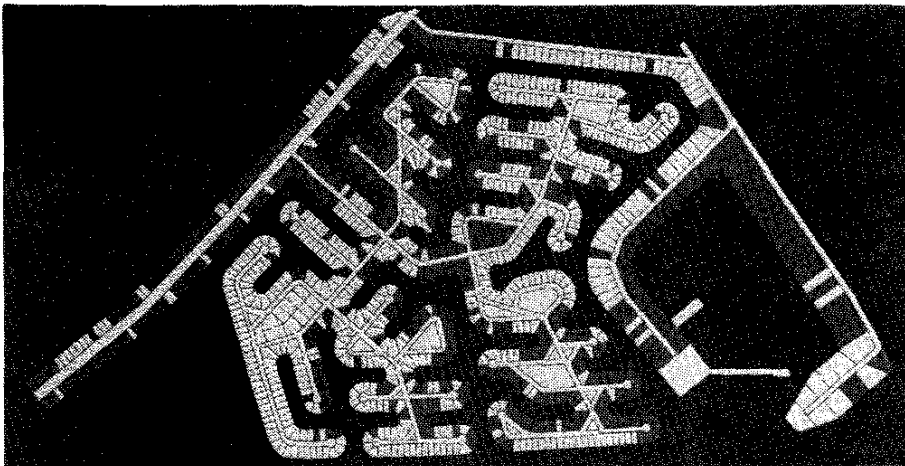

## NEIGHBOR TO NEIGHBORS

### A Local Newspaper Reporter

Although we enjoy a remarkably low crime rate in Eden Isles, I would like to call attention to a recent rash of thefts in our own yards. During the past month or so, there have been numerous incidents of items being stolen from parked cars -- including money, stereo equipment, and more. There have also



been a number of canal-related burglaries, with trolling motors, propellers, and other boat gear reported stolen. One thief even had the nerve to break into one of our guard houses, stealing a cellular phone several weeks ago.

In addition to these burglaries, I have personally noticed an increasing problem with unfamiliar boats

coming on planes, particularly late at night, making me wonder why these people are out speeding. Of course, we all know how outsiders like to ignore the "no wake" zone which is intended to protect our boats and bulkheads.

Another thing we should be aware of is that there have been a few recent burglary arrests of people who live right at our back door, on Pontchartrain Drive. Although many of our good friends and neighbors may live there, it is nonetheless alarming to know we have some known criminals residing so close to us.
