Board elections were held for 2020:

Neel-Schaffer, Inc. engineering gave a recap of the work that has been done to date on the Coastal Master plan and presented their preliminary risk reduction plan. Maps of the plan were on display and a power-point presentation was given that explained the process used to develop the plan which expands the entire parish lakefront, with several alternative plans for consideration.

The plan has been given to the USACE for their consideration to be included into their 3X3 Feasibility Study for flood control projects.
