Meeting was then open to questions from members present:

John Cervini - When will the Parish commit to resurfacing our street?

Ans.: Bonnie Peyroux - Parish has a 5 year plan to repair streets and since our bridge is being repaired, we probably will be on the end of that plan.

Naquin: Problem with holes in the street and parking on street over night. What happened to the cameras that we voted to have placed at the entrance?

Ans: Naomie explained her conversation with the Sheriff's department about how they cover this neighborhood and surrounding neighborhoods. Will have Sheriff's department representative at our Safety Meeting. Cameras were deferred by President Stephen Deep because he wants to get more than one estimate.

Question of the letters sent to MICOI members to pay dues to EIHOA. Deferred to Stephen Deep. Stephen informed members that letters should not have been sent - especially since our Board was not consulted. Our Board answered those invoices with a Cease and Desist letter which caused quite some unrest with

EIHOA Board. Ms. Dubisson is to facilitate a meeting of both Boards. When Ms. Edwards was asked if Clipper Estates received Invoices the answer was "No".

Hope Arriazo stood and complained that everyone was too emotionally involved over these letters. Karen Mathews explained the large amount of confusion among our members as it is she who receives the emails questioning the invoices.

Ed Peyroux brought up the fact that there has been trespassing and several houses were either broken into or were attempted to be broken into.

Stephen Deep had a recent problem with a trespasser who tore up his fence trying to get out of the lake late at night.

Terry Cederholme of the Sheriff's department said that Sunday is the busiest night of the week with vandalism and brake ins.

John Faust gave report of Levee Board - mitigation has been given to our area. This is a confession that a problem was created by the government that affects our properties. That problem is that when we built our homes, we were told at what elevation we were to build to be safe from flooding. Since that time the government has built levees that affect our area in a negative way, they have also closed off escape routes for incoming water to protect other areas at the risk of our area. Therefore it is not our fault or responsibility for flooding probability having increased. That fault lies with the government who authorized the changes that affected our homes.
